

# How to Change My Seat After Booking with American Airlines: The Complete Guide

## How Do I Modify a Reservation with American Airlines?

Seat changes are just one part of modifying a reservation; call  **+1(888)\_260\_0525** to handle the entire "ticket reissue" process.
